Applies to Coaches, Players, Parents, and all Spectators

Walkill Valley/High Point Recreational Basketball League continues to thrive and expand, thanks to the support of our parents and coaches. Our coaches do an outstanding job of teaching our children and advocating a fun atmosphere at both practices and games. However, occasionally problems arise at the various gyms used by our league, during games and/or practices. These problems range from unruly children, fights, vandalism to even "911" false alarms. These incidents are largely caused by the siblings of our young athletes, who are supposed to be watching their brothers and sisters.

Parents are reminded that they are responsible for overseeing their children that aren't playing, NOT the coaches, referees or town directors. We respectfully request you supervise your children at all times and assure you and your children adhere to the following rules:

- No food in the gymnasium (except water), where applicable
- No playing in the hallways or stage, where applicable
- No destroying school property....EVER
- No utilizing school equipment or apparatuses without permission
- No profanity
- No derogatory remarks toward the referees, players or coaches
- No littering
- No smoking in the building
- Be sportsmanlike or positive while cheering for your team

The town directors or referee has the right to remove anyone from the gym at his/her discretion, if rules are violated. Repeat offenders are subject to expulsion from the league.
